Steps to apply to the CGSP for Brazilian students in the following universities: UFG, UFPR, UFRJ, UFSCar, UFU, UFV, UNICAMP, UESC, USP (all campuses)

Deadline: MAY 20, 2018

- Must be a citizen or permanent resident of Brazil.
- 1st, 2nd or 3rd year in a partner university
- High academic performance and leadership potential



1. START YOUR APPLICATION

Click [HERE](#) to create an account/application. Fill in the general information to determine if you qualify as a candidate to the program.



3. WRITE TWO SHORT ESSAYS

You will need to write two personal statements (essays). **One of them must be written in English** and the other one can be in Portuguese. You decide which one. To see the topics, you need to continue filling out your application until you get to that section.

TIP: Write and proofread, have someone give you feedback, and modify as necessary until it is clear and concise. Essays must not exceed 500 words.



5. REVIEW APPLICATION

- **Fill out** application and include all relevant info.

- **Attach** high school and university transcripts, 2 personal statements, 2-page CV and signed certification form.

- **Review** and add comments, if necessary.

- Make sure **recommenders send their letters of rec. by May 20, 2018, 23:59 hr, Brasília Time.**

UNDERSTAND PROGRAM

Once you fully understand the program, you will be able to decide who your **two references** will be. Don't feel shy about sending them your updated CV and explaining the program to them.



2. PREPARE DOCUMENTS

Request high school and university transcripts ahead of time, and update your CV, which must be 2 pages long or less. *All documents need to be uploaded.*

TIP: Include a section on leadership!



4. TWO LETTERS OF REC.

You need to enter the two e-mail addresses of your recommenders in the application. When you do, they will receive a personal link with instructions to create your letter in English or in Portuguese. Letters are confidential and **you cannot** send them to us.

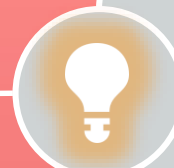


OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- Include all awards.
- Include all financial support, if it exists.
- Include all relevant extracurricular activities.
- Include all professional experience.

Note: it doesn't have to be from a job, necessarily.

- Include leadership examples.



6. SUBMIT APPLICATION

Once everything has been reviewed, click on the **SUBMIT BUTTON**.

TIP: Plan to submit a week before the deadline so that you anticipate any complications.



REMEMBER!

- Interviews will be in English.
- Participating in the program is a great way to improve your English proficiency!
- Leadership can be demonstrated in any position, not just at the very top of an organizational chart!
- Applying to an international program serves as preparation to apply to other international programs in the future!
