RESOLUTION - CEPEC 832**

Create and regulate Digital Library of Thesis and Dissertation - BDTD-UFG, under the Federal University of Goiás.

THE COUNCIL FOR EDUCATION, RESEARCH, EXTENSION AND CULTURE OF THE FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF GOIÁS, in exercise of its statutory and regimental assignments, meeting in plenary session held on August 7, 2007, in the light of case 23070. 000767/2007-95 and recital:

- (a) technical cooperation agreement No. 019/2006, concluded between the Brazilian Institute of Information in Science and Technology - Ministry of Science and Technology - MCT and the Federal University of Goiás - UFG;
- (b) the need to establish routine standards for the implementation of a system for making Theses and Dissertations produced in *stricto sensu* Graduate Programs, within the scope of UFG;
- c) the provisions of paragraph 2 of art. 53 of the UFG General Regiment;
- d) the deliberation of the Research and Graduate Chamber, held on March 15, 2007,

RESOLVES:

Art. 1 Create the Digital Library of Theses and Dissertations - BDTD / UFG, linked to the Central Library of the Federal University of Goiás, as an Organ, according to Article 53, Paragraph 1, Item IV of the UFG Statute, subordinated to the Pro-Rector for Research and Graduate Studies, and constitutes an additional service to Central Library.

Single paragraph. BDTD / UFG becomes part of the Brazilian Thesis and Dissertation Digital Library, pursuant to Technical Cooperation Agreement 019/2006, celebrated between the Brazilian Institute of Information in Science and Technology - IBICT from the Ministry of Science and Technology - MCT, and the Federal University of Goiás.

Art. 2 The purpose of BDTD / UFG is to make available electronically and disseminate, nationally and internationally, the Theses and Dissertations produced and approved in the *Stricto Sensu* Graduate Programs of the Federal University of Goiás.

Art. 3 The BDTD / UFG operates its activities in articulation with the UFG *stricto sensu* Graduate Programs and the Computational Resource Center - CERCOMP from UFG.

Art. 4 The *Stricto Sensu* Graduate Programs of the UFG:

I - keep the register and updated database for their regularly enrolled students as well as for permanent professors and collaborators of the respective programs;

II - guide the student about the mandatory deposit of Theses or Dissertations, in the final version;

III - collect the Authorization Form duly completed and through which the student makes his/her work available for disclosure through the electronic process, and the term will part of the structure of the Thesis or Dissertation and will be located on the back of face page;

IV - send to BDTD, through the UFG Graduate Studies Pro-Rector, a copy of the Thesis or Dissertation, bookbound in hardcover and in the electronic version, with the authorization incorporated and signed by the author.

Art. 5 The Computational Resources Center - CERCOMP is responsible to:

I - assist, technically, the implementation and maintenance of the system;

II - perform *backup* procedures to ensure access to information safely and efficiently within the standards of the IBICT.

Art. 6. The Central Library - BC / UFG is responsible to:

I - manage and operationalize the BDTD / UFG;

II - catalog the Theses and Dissertations approved by the UFG *stricto sensu* Graduate Programs;

III - make available to the public the collection of Theses and Dissertations cataloged;

IV - keep the local server operating without interruption through the CERCOMP.

Art. 7 The BDTD / UFG will be fed by Theses and Dissertations approved from the year 2006.

Article 8. The omitted cases shall be resolved by the Research and Graduate Studies Commission.
